



Club Rules and Code of Conduct.

1. The club shall be called Reeth & District Angling Club (open to any resident of the parishes of Muker, Melbecks, Arkengarthdale, Reeth, Grinton, and Marrick, to include Marske, and Ellerton.)
2. All members must hold a current ROD & LINE LICENCE.
3. The size limit for Trout to be ten inches from snout to fork of tail.
4. The bag limit [for Members Only] each day to be two fish per rod per day, however catch & release is strongly encouraged and is mandatory for all Day Ticket Holders.
5. Fishing methods Fly, Worm & Spinning which is only allowed on beats 1, 2, 3 & 4 and then not before May 1st and only in coloured water and with single pointed barbless or nipped barbed hooks only, no trebles. Beat 5 is exclusively Fly only any spinning will result in immediate suspension of membership.
6. Access to water must be gained by recognised routes only, stiles and gates to be used where possible, any damage to be reported to a committee member immediately.
7. Disturbance to livestock and wildlife to be kept to a minimum and special care to be given to nesting birds.
8. Any litter to be taken home any litter found to be removed. Priority to be given to fishing line.
9. No dogs while fishing.
10. Permits are NOT TRANSFERABLE.
11. Any landowner to whose water the club has access will be given a free permit to be used at his discretion.
12. Member's guest tickets will be available and limited to 5 per day.
13. Fishing permits to be carried at ALL TIMES whilst fishing and produced on request.
14. A FULL AND TRUE CATCH RETURN MUST BE MADE (EVEN A NIL RETURN) AND RETURNED TO THE CLUB SECRETARY BY 30TH NOVEMBER.
15. All rules outlined above have been agreed by the committee and will be strictly obeyed, any member found in breach of the rules may be brought before the committee to face disciplinary action.
